- **Effort/Attitude** – Parents emphasize the importance of education. Therefore, placing importance on effort and attitude toward school and studies.
- **Supplies** – Parents are responsible to supply necessary school supplies as per expectation letter from all subject areas.
- **Homework** – Parents should assist or check homework regularly to ensure reinforcement of classroom instruction. Reading time should be encouraged at a levels.
- **Parent/Teacher Conference** – Parents should attend Parent teacher conference night or day, or schedule to meet each teacher at a more convenient time.
- **Communication with Teacher/School** – Parent should read all district and school notices to be aware of any state test or events presented by the district or school. A district website is available for current news items which might affect community and/or district schools. Be aware of 5 week notice reports and report card dates. Regular agenda checks will help with daily contact of parents and teachers.

Los padres,

Nosotros, como padres, apoyaremos el aprendizaje de nuestros niños en las siguientes formas:

- **Vestimenta adecuada** - Los padres se familiarizarán con el código de vestimenta del distrito y de la North Middle School.
- **Esfuerzo/actitud** - Los padres enfatizarán la importancia de la educación. Por lo tanto, darán importancia al esfuerzo y la actitud hacia la escuela y los estudios.
- **Suministros** - Los padres son responsables de suministrar los materiales escolares necesarios según la carta de expectativas de todas las materias.

- **Comunicación con el maestro/a o la escuela** - los padres deben leer todos los avisos del distrito y de la escuela para estar al tanto de cualquier examen del estado o eventos presentados por el distrito o la escuela.
