Two-year participation rate information for students with disabilities on the state ELA exam at North Middle School includes:  • Current Year Participation Rate (Single Year) = 48.3%  • Previous Year Participation Rate = 48.7%  • Weighted Achievement Level = 1  The Consultation and Collaboration Team (CCT) determined this was a result of a number of complex factors, including the opt-out movement and the lack of parents' knowledge of changes to test and the impact of opting-out,
Provide a brief description of Consultation and Collaboration process for development of the plan.	The consultation and collaboration process aligned to guidance from the NYSED. In year 1, the CCT consisted of the school principal and assistant principals, teachers and teaching assistants who were selected by their representative bargaining units, and parents; some of whom also participate on the School Improvement Team (SIT). The CCT first reviewed two years' worth of ELA participation rate data for the subgroup of students with disabilities and participated in root cause analysis activities; disaggregating participation rate data by subgroup. The CCT then reviewed the participation rate improvement resources provided by the NYSED, and together selected those that were deemed to be most beneficial to all constituents at North Middle School. The CCT them developed a strategic participation rate improvement plan, as described: educating parents to the current changes to the State testing through the use of school wide assemblies,

communication through the school website, staff buying through professional development and collaboration, and revising school wide testing practices.

Describe the chosen strategies and key activities to be implemented to improve Participation Rate at the school.	The CCT prioritized guidance and resources that were provided by the NYSED. The implementation strategies selected included: A letter was sent to the community by the superintendent of schools articulating the importance of 3-8 testing. That letter included rationale provided on NYSED's Participation Rate 'Talking Points' memo; the CCT collaboratively planned and facilitated stakeholder meetings for families and staff alike, using the NYSED's sample participation rate meeting outline, and sample presentation materials; the CCT modified the NYSED's sample participation rate meeting flyers and distributed them broadly, in English and Spanish, to ensure high meeting attendance; the CCT enlisted the support of the BUFSD's Office of Funded Programs to highlight potential performance index improvement through decreased test refusal; and, the CCT utilized the NYSED's participation rate Q&A document at the end of all scheduled meetings.
